

## **EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST BUSHFIRE RECOVERY ROLES**

Towong Shire Council, with the support of the Victorian Government, has established a Bushfire Recovery Directorate (BRD) to oversee bushfire recovery - focusing on rebuilding and planning, economic development, support for the farming and primary production sectors and the ongoing wellbeing of community members.

Council is looking to fill a mixture of key support roles on a short-term basis (up to three months) while longer-term recruitment processes get underway.

All positions will be based in Corryong and will require extensive travel across the Upper Murray region. Each leadership position will be supported by a team dedicated to a community-led recovery model and will report to the Director Relief and Recovery.

These roles will be appointed to Upper Murray locals wherever possible.

### **Infrastructure Recovery**

Oversee the suite of services required to deliver restorative infrastructure works for the community.

### **Community Resilience and Recovery**

Lead community engagement and community development activities to provide support and information to residents and support the community to develop and achieve their vision for the region's future.

### **Economic Recovery**

Work closely with local businesses and industry stakeholders to determine economic impacts, link businesses with appropriate support options and advocate for specific recovery programs.

### **Recovery Community Development Officer x 3**

To work with the community to determine priorities and key recovery initiatives, and to deliver on those activities.
